6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to immunization, vaccination, mask,  
8 and medical requirements; providing an exemption  
9 process for a minor child; creating exemption  
10 procedures for adults; prescribing a penalty for  
11 violations; providing for codification; and providing  
12 an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3401 of Title 63, unless there  
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. Every minor child, through the parent, guardian, or legal  
18 custodian of the child, shall be exempt from any public or private  
19 immunization, vaccination, mask, or medical testing requirement or  
20 any other required medical procedure by providing one of the  
21 following:

22 1. A certificate of a licensed physician, as defined in  
23 subsection C of Section 725.2 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes,  
24 stating that the physical condition of the child is such that

1 receiving an immunization or vaccination, wearing a mask, or being  
2 subjected to medical testing or any other required medical procedure  
3 would endanger the life or health of the child; or

4 2. A written statement by the parent, guardian, or legal  
5 custodian of the child objecting to an immunization, vaccination,  
6 medical testing, or medical procedure of the child or mask  
7 requirement for the child.

8 B. Every adult shall be exempt from any public or private  
9 immunization, vaccination, mask, or medical testing requirement or  
10 any other required medical procedure by providing one of the  
11 following:

12 1. A certificate of a licensed physician, as defined in  
13 subsection C of Section 725.2 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes,  
14 stating that the physical condition of the adult is such that  
15 receiving an immunization, vaccination, wearing a mask, or being  
16 subjected to medical testing or any other required medical procedure  
17 would endanger the life or health of the adult; or

18 2. A written statement by the adult objecting to an  
19 immunization, vaccination, medical testing, or medical procedure of  
20 the adult or mask requirement for the adult.

21 C. Any person or entity found by the Office of the Attorney  
22 General or district attorney, upon prosecution, to be in violation  
23 of subsection A or B of this section shall be subject to a fine of  
24 Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) for each violation.
