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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1127, as
14	amended by Section 1, Chapter 413, O.S.L. 2014 (47 O.S. Supp. 2015,
15	Section 1127), is amended to read as follows:
16	Section 1127. A. All vehicles owned by members of the Armed
17	Forces of the United States, the Reserve Corps of the Armed Forces
18	of the United States, and the Oklahoma National Guard or their
19	spouses assigned to duty in this state in compliance with official
20	military or naval orders or owned by the spouse, who resides in
21	Oklahoma, of a member of the Armed Forces of the United States
22	serving in a foreign country, which vehicles are not being used in a
23	trade or business or for any commercial purpose, are hereby
24	classified specially for vehicle license and registration purposes

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1 in this state. Any such vehicle which is not registered and 2 licensed for the current year in the state of residence or domicile 3 of the serviceman service member, Guardsman, or Reservist or of the spouse owning the vehicle must be registered for the current year in 4 5 Oklahoma as herein provided, except that any such vehicle which has been licensed in some other state by such serviceman service member, 6 7 Guardsman, Reservist, or spouse while the serviceman service member, Guardsman, or Reservist was stationed in the other state may be 8 9 operated in this state for the remainder of the year or period for 10 which it is licensed. If such vehicle currently is registered with 11 the Armed Forces of the United States rather than being registered 12 in a state and the serviceman service member, Guardsman, or Reservist is transferred to a duty station within this state 13 pursuant to military orders, the serviceman service member, 14 15 Guardsman, Reservist, or spouse owning the vehicle shall not be required to register the vehicle in this state for a period of 16 thirty (30) days after the date the serviceman service member, 17 Guardsman, or Reservist is required to report for duty pursuant to 18 19 the military.

The serviceman <u>service member</u>, Guardsman, Reservist, or spouse applying for the registration of any such vehicle shall submit an appropriate statement, to be attached to the vehicle registration application, showing the following: A description of the vehicle owned by <u>the</u> applicant; the state and address of the applicant's

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1 legal residence or domicile; and that the applicant or applicant's spouse is on active duty in the Armed Forces of the United States 2 3 assigned or stationed at a named location in compliance with official military orders. The statement shall be signed by the 4 5 applicant and certified to by a proper officer of the organization to which applicant the service member, Guardsman, or Reservist is 6 7 assigned for duty or where the applicant is the spouse of such serviceman, Guardsman, or Reservist serving in a foreign country, 8 9 the statement shall be signed by the spouse under the penalties of 10 perjury. Provided, in lieu of certification by an officer, the 11 applicant may submit copies of written orders documenting that the 12 service member, Guardsman, or Reservist is on active duty at the time of application for registration. The application shall be 13 accompanied by a registration fee of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00). 14 Any Oklahoma resident who is stationed out of state due to 15 Β. an official assignment of the Armed Forces of the United States or 16 their spouse shall be entitled to register his or her vehicle or 17 vehicles in this state for the same registration fee afforded 18 members of the Armed Forces of the United States assigned to duty in 19 this state pursuant to subsection A of this section. Such Oklahoma 20

21 resident or their spouse who is stationed out of state due to an 22 official assignment of the Armed Forces of the United States shall 23 be exempt from the vehicle inspection requirements of Section 1105 24 of this title; provided, such Oklahoma resident or his or her spouse

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1 who is stationed out of state presents valid documentation 2 acceptable to the Oklahoma Tax Commission evidencing that such 3 inspection has been made by an out-of-state authority acceptable to 4 the Tax Commission.

5 Any Oklahoma resident who is stationed out of state due to an 6 official assignment of the Armed Forces of the United States may 7 authorize his or her parents <u>a designated representative</u> to register 8 his or her vehicle or vehicles as provided for in this subsection if 9 the serviceman <u>service member</u>, Guardsman, or Reservist is not able 10 to register the vehicle at the appropriate time.

11 C. Any Oklahoma resident who is a member of the Armed Forces of 12 the United States, Reserve Corps of the Armed Forces of the United States or the Oklahoma National Guard stationed outside of the state 13 due to official assignment of the Armed Forces of the United States, 14 15 or his or her spouse, shall be exempt from the penalties assessed pursuant to paragraph 4 of subsection C of Section 1115, subsection 16 F of Section 1132 and subsection C of Section 1151 of this title for 17 the duration of such official assignment and for a period of sixty 18 (60) days after such assignment ends. If registration is not 19 completed after the sixtieth day, the expiration date and the period 20 for assessment of penalties shall commence on the sixty-first day. 21 The exemption provided for in this section shall be granted only if 22 the serviceman service member, Guardsman, Reservist, or spouse 23 registering such vehicle submits an appropriate statement, to be 24

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1 attached to the vehicle registration application, showing the following: A description of the vehicle owned by the applicant; the 2 3 state and address of the applicant's legal residence or domicile; and that the applicant or applicant's spouse is on active duty in 4 5 the Armed Forces of the United States assigned or stationed at a named location outside the state in compliance with official 6 military orders. The statement shall be signed by the applicant and 7 certified to by a proper officer of the organization to which the 8 9 applicant service member, Guardsman, or Reservist is assigned for 10 duty or where the applicant is the spouse of such serviceman, 11 Guardsman, or Reservist serving outside the state, the statement 12 shall be signed by his or her spouse under the penalties of perjury. Provided, in lieu of certification by an officer, the applicant may 13 submit copies of written orders documenting that the service member, 14 Guardsman, or Reservist is on active duty at the time of application 15 16 for registration.

The reduced registration fee provided herein shall not apply 17 D. to vehicles owned by retired members of the Armed Forces, inactive 18 members of the Reserve Corps of the Armed Forces, inactive members 19 of the Oklahoma National Guard and other members and former members 20 of the Armed Forces of the United States who are not on active duty. 21 SECTION 2.
