Upon request of a majority of the 17 landowners residing within a basin or subbasin, the Board is 18 authorized to require that water wells be metered and that such 19 meters as the Board shall approve be utilized by the applicant and 20 placed under seal, subject to reading by the agents of the Board at 21 any time. The Oklahoma Water Resources Board shall require that all 22 water wells requiring a permit to take and use groundwater from the 23 Oklahoma Water Resources Board be equipped with water well flow 24 meters or an alternative measuring system as defined by the Board.

Such measuring systems shall remain on the well and be in proper

operating condition at all times when groundwater is being produced.

Data from the measuring system shall be utilized for the annual

groundwater use report. The Board may also require that the

applicant report the reading of such meters or alternative measuring

system at reasonable intervals.

B. Beginning January 1, 2025, a five-year allocation of the maximum annual yield of the basin or subbasin may be approved for a regular permit. An applicant for a five-year allocation shall be required to submit annual usage as determined by a water well flow meter and pay the annual permit fee. If approved by the Board, the applicant may exceed the maximum annual yield in any year of the five-year allocation; provided, the applicant shall adhere to the cumulative maximum annual yield for the basin or subbasin over the five-year period.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
