"Harmful woody species" means a 19 tree or shrub species that is rapidly encroaching into adjoining 20 lands and is likely to cause harm to the environment or economy. 21 Harmful woody species include, but are not limited to, juniperus 22 virginiana (eastern red cedar), juniperus scopulorum (Rocky Mountain
