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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to insurance; creating the Health
8 Insurance Modernization Act; requiring health benefit
9 plans to state and list all medical treatment and
10 services covered and excluded; requiring any medical
11 treatment or service not specifically excluded to be
12 treated as covered; providing for codification;
13 providing for noncodification; and providing an
14 effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
17 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

18 This act shall be known as and may be cited as the "Health
19 Insurance Modernization Act".

20 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3661 of Title 36, unless there
22 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 Every health benefit plan in this state offered on or after
24 January 1, 2019, shall state and list within the policy, which shall
be provided to the insured prior to the effective date of the

1 policy, every benefit, medical treatment and service offered and
2 covered under the policy and the deductible, coinsurance and
3 copayments applicable to the covered service. The health benefit
4 plan shall also state and exclude any medical treatments or services
5 that are not offered or covered under the policy; provided, that a
6 medical treatment or service not specifically excluded as required
7 by this section shall be treated as a similarly covered medical
8 treatment or service, and the insurer shall provide coverage and
9 apply the same deductible, coinsurance and copayments for the
10 medical treatment or service in the same manner as a similarly
11 covered service in the policy.

12 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.

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
