12	An Act relating to the Oklahoma Conservation Commission; creating the Arkansas River Levee
13	Projects Revolving Fund; providing for authorized revenue sources; stating authorized purposes;
14	prescribing method for expenditures; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and
15	declaring an emergency.
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18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
19	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-3-601 of Title 27A, unless
21	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
22	There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
23	for the Oklahoma Conservation Commission to be designated the
24	"Arkansas River Levee Projects Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a

1 continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall 2 consist of all monies received by the Oklahoma Conservation Commission from such sources as may be provided by law, if an 3 4 eligible levee project has or will receive in excess of One Hundred 5 Million Dollars (\$100,000,000.00) of federal matching funds for the 6 project. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby 7 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma 8 Conservation Commission for the purpose of constructing or repairing 9 levees in proximity to the Arkansas River, subject to the federal 10 matching funds requirement. Expenditures from said fund shall be 11 made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims 12 filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of 13 Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment. 14 This act shall become effective July 1, 2024. SECTION 2. 15 SECTION 3.
