Fund established in Section 40-123 of this title. Any person convicted of failure to yield a right-of-way and who causes a serious bodily injury as a result of such violation may, in addition to any other fine or penalty, be assessed a fee in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) to be deposited in the Motorcycle Safety and Education Program Revolving Fund. For the purposes of this section, a serious bodily injury is an injury that is serious in nature but does not quite rise to the level of injury of great bodily injury or a fatality.

The monies deposited as provided in this section subsection shall be used to promote public awareness of the dangers of driving while under the influence of alcohol or any controlled substance and to promote motorcycle safety and defensive driving for youth.

- B. In addition to the fee provided in subsection A of this section, the court may impose additional penalties, including:
 - 1. A remedial driving course;

- 2. A loss of driver license for ninety (90) days; or
- 3. A payment of restitution of no less than Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00), but no more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00).
 - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
