HOUSE BILL 3316

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety; amending 63 O.S. 2021, Section 2-309B, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 69, O.S.L. 2022 (63 O.S. Supp. 2023, Section 2-309B), which relates to definitions in the Anti-Drug Diversion Act; amending dispenser definition; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2021, Section 2-309B, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 69, O.S.L. 2022 (63 O.S. Supp. 2023, Section 2-309B), is amended to read as follows:

Section 2-309B. For the purposes of the Anti-Drug Diversion Act:

1. "Bureau" means the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control;

2. "Dispenser" means a person who distributes a Schedule II controlled dangerous substance, but does not include a licensed hospital pharmacy including when they provide the first twenty-four (24) hours' worth of Schedule II controlled dangerous substance for a patient post-discharge to a long-term care facility or a licensed

1 nurse or medication aide who administers such a substance at the  
2 direction of a licensed physician;

3 3. "Dispenser's registration number" means the dispenser's  
4 Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control  
5 registration number or, in the case of a pharmacist, the National  
6 Association of Boards of Pharmacy number for the pharmacy where the  
7 dispensation is made;

8 4. "Exception report" means an output of data indicating  
9 Schedule II controlled dangerous substance dispensation which is  
10 outside expected norms for a prescriber practicing a particular  
11 specialty or field of health care, for a dispenser doing business in  
12 a particular location, or for a recipient;

13 5. "Recipient" means the person for whom a prescription is  
14 prescribed and who is the lawful intended ultimate user;

15 6. "Recipient's agent" means a person who is authorized by the  
16 ultimate user to pick up the recipient's medication and deliver it  
17 to the recipient or a person who claims a prescription other than  
18 the person to whom the medication is prescribed;

19 7. "Recipient's identification number" and "recipient's agent's  
20 identification number" means the unique number contained on forms of  
21 identification listed in 8 CFR 274a.2(b)(1)(v)(A) and (B);

22 8. "Registrant" means a person, persons, corporation or other  
23 entity who has been issued by the Director of the Oklahoma State  
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1 Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control a registration  
2 pursuant to Section 2-302 of this title; and

3 9. "State" means any state, territory, or possession of the  
4 United States, the District of Columbia, or foreign nation.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.

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
