17	A. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Riley's Rule".
18	B. Each school district board of education shall have on-site
19	at each football event an emergency medical provider for the
20	duration of the football event and a jump bag containing emergency
21	medical equipment.
22	C. For purposes of this section:
23	1. "Football event" means a school-sponsored football sporting
	event which is individual or team-based, outside of school property

or within school property, and a competition where secondary-schoolage individuals are participating;

- 2. "Emergency medical care provider" means an employee or volunteer member of a public or private organization, firefighter, emergency medical technician, physician, nurse practitioner or physician assistant with emergency medical services training and experience having responsibility for the delivery of health services to individuals experiencing illness or injury; and
- 3. "Emergency medical services training" means training in the prehospital assessment and treatment of a sick or injured individual initiated at the scene of an incident and continued through the transport and transfer, if found appropriate, of the individual to a medical facility or other appropriate location.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
