An age less than thirty-five (35) years old and was Been manufactured for use in either the United States Armed Forces or any 21 22 country that was a member of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization 23 at the time the vehicle was manufactured. Such vehicle shall have

1	been subsequently authorized for sale to civilians, except that
2	military surplus vehicle does not include a tracked vehicle;
3	3. For each occupant, safety belts or safety shoulder harnesses
4	which shall be installed pursuant to 49 C.F.R., Section 571.208 et
5	seq.; and
6	4. Equipment required by the provisions of Sections 12-201
7	through 12-232 of <del>Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes</del> <u>this title</u> , with
8	respect to equipment on vehicles.
9	B. A military surplus vehicle operated on the streets and
10	highways of this state shall be registered as a motor vehicle.
11	C. Military surplus vehicles may be used as other vehicles of
12	the same type, except military surplus vehicles may not transport
13	people for hire.
