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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6970 of Title 36, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	As used in this act:
19	1. "Defined cost sharing" means a deductible payment or
20	coinsurance amount imposed on an enrollee for a covered prescription
21	drug under the enrollee's health benefit plan;
22	2. "Insurer" means any entity that provides a health benefit
23	plan in this state, including, but not limited to, a licensed
24	insurance company, group hospital service corporation, a not-for-

profit hospital service and medical indemnity corporation, a health maintenance organization, a preferred provider organization, or any other entity subject to regulation by the Insurance Commissioner;

3. "Price protection rebate" means a negotiated price concession that accrues directly or indirectly to the insurer, or other party on behalf of the insurer, in the event of an increase in the wholesale acquisition cost of a drug above a specified threshold; and

4. "Rebate" means:

- a. negotiated price concessions, including, but not limited to, base price concessions, whether described as a "rebate" or otherwise, and reasonable estimates of any price protection rebates and performance-based price concessions that may accrue directly or indirectly to the insurer during the coverage year from a manufacturer, dispensing pharmacy, or other party in connection with the dispensing or administration of a prescription drug, and
- b. reasonable estimates of any negotiated price concessions, fees and other administrative costs that are passed through, or are reasonably anticipated to be passed through, to the insurer and serve to reduce the insurer's liabilities for a prescription drug.

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1 NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified SECTION 2. 2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6971 of Title 36, unless there 3 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 4 An enrollee's defined cost sharing for each prescription drug 5 shall be calculated at the point of sale based on a price that is 6 reduced by an amount equal to at least eighty percent (80%) of all 7 rebates received, or to be received, in connection with the 8 dispensing or administration of the prescription drug.
