NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6057.6 of Title 36, unless there 18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 19 An insurer issuing health benefit plans in this state shall not 20 make a material change to a policy benefit, including the removal of 21 a patient provider from a policyholder's network contract, at any 22 time in which the policy is in force, except in the case of medical 23 malpractice, billing and collection violations, as spelled out in 24 the provider agreement, or a violation of ethical standards as set

1	forth by the State Department of Health, without the expressed
2	written agreement from the policyholder.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
