18	A. A public school district, a charter school sponsored as
19	provided for in Section 3-132 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes
20	and a virtual charter school sponsored by the Statewide Virtual
21	Charter School Board pursuant to Section 3-145.3 of Title 70 of the
22	Oklahoma Statutes shall be prohibited from using State Aid
23	allocation or any other state-appropriated revenue to contract with

3 B. For the purposes of this section, "private extracurricular4 lessons" shall include, but not be limited to:

5 1. Gymnastics lessons;

6 2. Music lessons; and

3. Athletic performance lessons.

8 C. The provisions of this section shall not apply to teachers 9 contracted by a public school district pursuant to Section 6-101 of 10 Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes or teachers or other personnel 11 contracted by a virtual charter school or a charter school pursuant 12 to Section 3-135 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

D. The State Board of Education and the Statewide Virtual
Charter School Board shall promulgate rules necessary to implement
the provisions of this section.

16 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-125 of Title 70, unless there 18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. A public school district, a charter school sponsored as
