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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 1210.229-1,
17	is amended to read as follows:
18	Section 1210.229-1 Sections 1210.229-1 through 1210.229-5 of
19	this title and Section 2 of this act shall be known and may be cited
20	as the "Oklahoma Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention and Life Skills
21	Education Act".
22	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1210.229-8 of Title 70, unless
24	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. As part of the comprehensive integrated curriculum for
 substance abuse programs provided in Section 1210.229-5 of Title 70
 of the Oklahoma Statutes, each school district shall annually
 provide research-based instruction related to fentanyl abuse
 prevention and drug poisoning awareness to students in grades six
 through twelve.

- 7 B. The instruction required by this section shall include:
- 8 1. Suicide prevention;

9 2. Prevention of the abuse of and addiction to fentanyl;
10 3. Awareness of local school and community resources and how to
11 access those resources; and

4. Health education that includes information about substance
use and abuse of fentanyl, including youth substance use and abuse
of fentanyl.

C. The instruction required by this section may be provided byan organization or an employee or agent of an organization that is:

17 1. A public or private institution of higher education;

18 2. A library;

- 19 3. A community service organization;
- 20 4. A religious organization;
- 21 5. A local public health agency; or

22 6. An organization employing mental health professionals.

D. To educate students about the dangers posed by fentanyl and
 the risks of fentanyl poisoning, including overdose, the Governor

1	shall designate a week to be known as Fentanyl Poisoning Awareness
2	Week in public schools. Fentanyl Poisoning Awareness Week may
3	include age-appropriate instruction, including instruction on the
4	prevention of the abuse of and addiction to fentanyl, as determined
5	by each school district.
6	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
7	SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
8	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
9	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
10	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
