7	An Act relating to the Oklahoma Health Care
8	Authority; defining term; directing the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to implement a rural health
9	care funding pilot program; providing requirements of program; directing the Governor to appoint an
10	Executive Director; providing for quarterly meetings; directing the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to
11	promulgate rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.
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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1010.14 of Title 56, unless
17	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. As used in this section, "rural county" means a county with
19	a population of less than thirty thousand (30,000) according to the
20	most recent Federal Decennial Census with annual population
21	estimates.
22	B. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall develop and
23	implement a rural health care funding pilot program to support
24	access to health care and health care facilities in rural counties

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in the state. The program shall focus on the use of Medicaid
reimbursements and state appropriations to the Oklahoma Health Care
Authority. The pilot program shall:

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- 1. Evaluate the existing systems in which medical services are delivered in rural counties;
- 2. Identify the rural counties with reduced access to health care facilities and health care providers;
- 3. Evaluate the screening mechanisms for Medicaid recipients seeking health care services;
  - 4. Assess the administrative and duplicative expenses;
- 5. Examine the role of the State Department of Health and county health departments' delivery systems;
- 6. Determine the feasibility of statewide expansion of the program;
- 7. Evaluate the use of state appropriations and federally matched Medicaid dollars to deliver health care services; and
- 8. Develop methods for coordinating state and local services and the use of available funds to assist health care facilities in providing access to health care in rural counties.
- C. The Governor shall appoint an Executive Director for the rural health care funding pilot program.
- D. The Executive Director shall meet quarterly with a representative appointed by the Speaker of the House of

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Representatives and a representative appointed by the President Pro
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    Tempore of the Senate to review the status of the pilot program.

            The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall promulgate rules as
    necessary to implement the provisions of this section.
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        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
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
