AMENDATORY 10 O.S. 2021, Section 405.4, is 19 amended to read as follows: 20 Section 405.4 A. Any person with a bachelor's degree or 21 postgraduate degree shall be considered as having met the 22 educational requirements for a director of a full-time child care 23 center required by the Department of Human Services. Nothing in 2.4 this section shall be construed as to affect annual continuing

education requirements. The director of a child care center may
also qualify as <u>a master teacher when meeting the master teacher</u>

qualifications. Directors qualifying as master teachers are
eligible for probationary periods.

- B. Any person with an associate's degree, bachelor's degree, postgraduate degree, or two (2) years of experience in a professional child care setting or related educational field shall be considered as having met the educational requirements for a master teacher for children of all ages. Nothing in this section shall be construed as to affect annual continuing education requirements.
- B. C. Any person replacing a master teacher at a child care center, including newer and expanding child care centers, shall be granted a one-year probationary period to fulfill the educational qualifications required by the Department for a master teacher.

 During the probationary period, the person pursuing the educational qualifications needed for master teacher shall carry the full authority of a master teacher. The Department may extend the probationary period an additional year as long as the person is actively pursuing that goal.
- C. D. Licensed child care facilities opened or expanded before November 1, 2016, shall have thirty-five (35) square feet of floor area per infant in rooms occupied only by infants. New construction and existing space not previously licensed for child care after

1	November 1, 2016, shall have forty (40) square feet of floor area
2	per infant in rooms occupied only by infants.
3	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 426 of Title 10, unless there is
5	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
6	The number of master teachers required for Reaching for the
7	Stars program compliance shall be based on the number of children
8	enrolled in the child care center. For purposes of this section,
9	enrollment shall be determined by rounding to the nearest whole
10	number according to standard mathematical practices.
11	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
12	SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
13	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
14	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
15	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
