8 An Act relating to children; directing that certain
9 documents be given to certain persons; providing for
10 codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-7-621 of Title 10A, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A person who has been placed in the custody of the Office of
17 Juvenile Affairs, who has attained eighteen (18) years of age, and
18 who is being released from the custody of the Office of Juvenile
19 Affairs with a plan to re-enter the community as a resident of the
20 State shall be given the following documents pertaining to the
21 person upon release:

22 1. An official or certified copy of the United States birth
23 certificate;

1 2. A Social Security card issued by the Commissioner of Social
2 Security;

3 3. Information about how to obtain health insurance and
4 personal medical records;

5 4. A state-issued driver license or identification card; and

6 5. Any educational transcripts, diplomas, or professional
7 certificates earned while in the custody of the Office of Juvenile
8 Affairs.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
