NEW LAW 16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3311.19 of Title 70, unless 17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 18 The Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training may offer 19 training that provides instruction for a peace officer on how to 20 alert a school district or charter school about the presence of a 21 minor child or a child who has reached eighteen (18) years of age 22 and continues to be enrolled in high school if that child has been 23 identified at the scene of a traumatic event or an event that 24 involved a response from an emergency 9-1-1 service. The peace

1	officer may only release the student's name directly to the school
2	district or charter school and state that the student was present at
3	the scene of a traumatic event.
4	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
