6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to cities and towns; amending 11 O.S.
8 2011, Section 27-115, which relates to prosecutions
9 by verified complaint; requiring allowance of certain
type of complaint subscription; and providing an
effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2011, Section 27-115, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 27-115. A. All prosecutions commenced in the municipal
16 court shall be by complaint which shall be subscribed by the person
17 making the complaint and shall be verified before a judge, the court
18 clerk, a deputy court clerk, or a police officer. No warrant for
19 arrest shall be issued until the complaint has been approved by the
20 judge of the municipal court. All prosecutions for the violation of
21 municipal ordinances shall be styled, "The _____ (City or Town)
22 of _____ (name the municipality) vs. _____
23 (naming the person or persons charged)".

1 B. No municipal court not of record shall prohibit a citizen
2 from subscribing a complaint, as authorized under subsection A of
3 this section, related to a reckless driving event when the complaint
4 is based on evidence captured by the citizen with a dashboard
5 camera.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
