1. An attorney of his or her choice, or if he or she has no
funds, the public defender or other attorney assigned by the court
to assist indigents, whose telephone number shall be posted;
2. A bail bondsman; and
3. A relative or other person.
The telephone calls shall be provided immediately upon request, or
as soon as practicable.
SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
