A judge who violates the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction, 4 5 be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in the custody of 6 the Department of Corrections for a term of not more than two (2) 7 years, or a fine of not less than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) 8 and not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00), or by 9 both such fine and imprisonment. 10 As used in this section, "sexual relationship" means an В. 11 established course of sexual relations. 12 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
