7	An Act relating to the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority;
8	amending 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1711, which relates to turnpike tolls; making certain exemption for
9	counties; and providing an effective date.
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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2021, Section 1711, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 1711. The A. Except as provided in subsection B of
17	this section, the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority, subject to the
18	provisions hereof, is hereby authorized to fix, revise, charge and
19	collect tolls for the use of each turnpike project and the different
20	parts or sections thereof, except for use by law enforcement
21	officers responsible for enforcing the traffic laws and the general
22	laws of the state and federal governments on turnpikes, who shall be
23	entitled to free use of every such project in the performance of
24	official duties connected with such turnpike project, and to

1 contract with any person, partnership, association or corporation 2 desiring the use of any part thereof, including the right-of-way 3 adjoining the paved portion, for placing thereon telephone, 4 telegraph, electric light or power lines, gas stations, garages, 5 stores, hotels, restaurants and advertising signs, or for any other 6 purpose except for tracks for railroad or railway use, and to fix 7 the terms, conditions, rents and rates of charges for such use. 8 Such tolls, subject to the other restrictions hereof, shall be so 9 fixed and adjusted in respect of the aggregate of tolls from the 10 turnpike project or projects in connection with which the bonds of 11 any issue shall have been issued as to provide a fund sufficient 12 with other revenues, if any, to pay (a) the cost of maintaining, 13 repairing, and operating such turnpike project or projects, and (b) 14 the principal of and the interest of such bonds as the same shall 15 become due and payable, and to create reserves for such purposes. 16 The tolls and all other revenues derived from the turnpike project 17 or projects in connection with which the bonds of any issue shall 18 have been issued, except such part thereof as may be necessary to 19 pay such cost of maintenance, repair, and operation and to provide 20 such reserves therefor as may be provided for in the resolution 21 authorizing the issuance of such bonds or in the trust agreement 22 securing the same shall be set aside at such regular intervals as 23 may be provided in such resolution or such trust agreement in a 24 sinking fund which is hereby pledged to, and charged with, the \_ \_

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1 payment of (a) the interest upon such bonds as such interest shall 2 fall due, (b) the principal of such bonds as the same shall fall 3 due, (c) the necessary charges of paying agents for paying principal 4 and interest, and (d) the redemption price or the purchase price of 5 bonds retired by call or purchase as therein provided, which are a 6 charge against such fund. The use and disposition of monies to the 7 credit of such sinking fund shall be subject to the provisions of 8 the resolution authorizing the issuance of such bonds or of such 9 trust agreement. Except as may otherwise be provided in such 10 resolution or such trust agreement, such sinking fund shall be a 11 fund for all such bonds without distinction or priority of one over 12 another. The monies in the sinking fund, less such reserve as may 13 be provided in such resolution or trust agreement, if not used 14 within a reasonable time for the purchase of bonds for cancellation 15 as above provided, shall be applied to the redemption of bonds at 16 the redemption price then applicable. Any person who leases, rents, 17 or acquires control of any gas station, garage, store, hotel, or 18 restaurant must have been a resident of, or been doing business in, 19 Oklahoma for the past five (5) years. Notwithstanding anything else 20 herein contained to the contrary, the Corporation Commission of the 21 State of Oklahoma shall exercise the jurisdiction now or hereafter 22 vested in it to regulate and control the operation of motor carriers 23 of passengers and freight, using or desiring to use any turnpike 24 project, in the manner and to the extent that it regulates or \_ \_

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1 controls such carriers using the highways of the state. The 2 Authority shall not discriminate against any group or class or 3 individual member thereof in fixing the amount of toll, rents, or 4 charge for the use of the turnpike project. 5 B. The Oklahoma Turnpike Authority shall not charge tolls for 6 the use of any turnpike by the following: 7 1. Law enforcement officers responsible for enforcing the 8 traffic laws and the general laws of the state and federal 9 governments on turnpikes who use the turnpike in the performance of 10 official duties connected with such turnpike project; or 11 2. County vehicles and county employees if traveling on 12 turnpikes for official county business. 13 SECTION 2.
