12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 391 of Title 10, unless there is
14	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
15	Inpatient and residential-based facilities providing services to any
16	child with a disability, as defined in Section 1-1-105 of Title 10A
17	of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall post, in a public area, contact
18	information for Oklahoma's designated Protection and Advocacy System
19	and a statement that the System may be contacted to confidentially
20	report incidents of, or suspected incidents of, abuse or neglect.
21	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 10-104.1 of Title 43A, unless
23	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
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1	Inpatient and residential-based facilities providing services to
2	vulnerable adults, as defined in Section 10-103 of Title 43A of the
3	Oklahoma Statutes, shall post, in a public area, contact information
4	for Oklahoma's designated Protection and Advocacy System and a
5	statement that the System may be contacted to confidentially report
6	incidents of, or suspected incidents of, abuse or neglect.
7	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
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
