13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 334 of Title 61, unless there is
15	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall
17	display the national motto of the United States in a prominently
18	visible location in all state buildings. The placement and size of
19	the display shall be in keeping with the placement and size of the
20	display of the national motto in the United States Capitol Visitor
21	Center. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall be
22	directly responsible for the provisions of this act, including any

related expenses.

B. In the event that the legality or constitutionality of the display is challenged in a court of law, the Oklahoma Attorney General is hereby authorized to prepare and present a legal defense of the display. C. The display of the national motto shall not be construed to mean that the State of Oklahoma favors any particular religion or denomination thereof over others. D. Nothing in this act shall apply to any building owned by a school district. SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
