L5	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 72 O.S. 2021, Section 63.10, is

L7	Section 63.10 A. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs
L8	is hereby authorized to establish within said the Department or
L 9	within any of the institutions operated by the Department training
20	programs to train necessary personnel for the Department or its
21	institutions, or may arrange for programs with any public or private
22	school, entity, or institution within this state having available
23	facilities for training. Training may occur individually pursuant
24	to the Quality Workforce for Oklahoma's Heroes Act or in groups

pursuant to this section. Funds of the Department or its institutions may be used to pay salaries or tuition and subsistence for employees or prospective employees in said training programs, pursuant to the provisions of subsection B of this section.

B. Any employee or prospective employee who, while receiving such training, is paid a salary, or for whom tuition and subsistence are furnished shall enter into a contract with the Department prior to receiving any payment for salary, tuition, or subsistence. The contract shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations promulgated by the Oklahoma Veterans Commission and shall include a stipulation that, unless the employee or prospective employee continues in the employ of the Department for a period equivalent of time that is equal to or greater than the length of the training, the employee or prospective employee shall reimburse the Department or institution for the amount of money paid to or for him or her by the Department during the training period.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
