AS INTRODUCED
An Act relating to renewable natural gas; requiring
the Oklahoma Corporation Commission to promulgate certain rules; providing for codification; and
providing an effective date.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 801.8 of Title 17, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
The Oklahoma Corporation Commission shall promulgate rules
requiring natural gas utilities to reduce methane emissions by
establishing feasible incremental goals for increasing percentages
of renewable gas in the overall gas supply. The rules shall allow
natural gas utilities to procure and develop renewable gas and
recover investment costs in renewable natural-gas-related
infrastructure. The rules shall update the state's renewable fuel
standard to more proactively promote biogas, renewable natural gas
and hydrogen as solutions for reducing methane emissions and other

1	environmental problems. In addition, the rules shall provide for
2	the production of educational materials to provide Oklahoma
3	residents with information regarding renewable natural gas and its
4	positive environmental impacts and benefits.
5	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
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
