4 daily cost no later than September 30. If the county's actual daily
5 cost is accepted by the Department that shall be the reimbursement
6 rate for the county beginning the next fiscal year. If the
7 Department rejects the county's actual daily cost application, then
8 the actual daily cost reimbursement shall be determined by the State
9 Auditor and shall be imposed beginning the next fiscal year. The
10 Department shall distribute the reimbursement on a monthly basis
11 upon receipt and approval of a billing statement from the county.
12 The county shall use the reimbursement to defray expenses of
13 equipping and maintaining the jail and payment of personnel. ~~The~~
14 ~~provisions in this act shall be implemented by the Department to~~
15 ~~allow sufficient time for application to FY-2019.~~ The Department of
16 Corrections shall reimburse the county for the emergency medical
17 care for physical injury or illness of the inmate retained under
18 this act if the injury or illness is directly related to the
19 incarceration and the county is required by law to provide such care
20 for inmates in the jail. The Department shall not pay fees for
21 medical care in excess of the rates established for Medicaid
22 providers. The state shall not be liable for medical charges in
23 excess of the Medicaid scheduled rate. The Director may accept any
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1 inmate required to have extended medical care upon application of
2 the county.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
