All fire extinguishers shall 18 be inspected annually by a licensed contractor. A Class K-rated, 19 portable fire extinguisher is required for all cooking equipment 20 involving solid fuels or vegetable or animal oils and fats. All 21 portable fire extinguishers shall be in clear view and immediately 22 available for use. 23 24
