11 An Act relating to fire suppression; providing for
12 portable fire extinguishers in mobile food
13 establishments; providing for annual inspection;
14 providing termination date; providing for
15 codification; and declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 325.20 of Title 74, unless there
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. In lieu of an automatic fire extinguishing system, portable
21 fire extinguishers shall be installed in mobile food establishments
22 that produce smoke or grease-laden vapors. All fire extinguishers
23 shall be inspected annually by a licensed contractor. A Class K-
24 rated, portable fire extinguisher is required for all cooking

1 equipment involving solid fuels or vegetable or animal oils and
2 fats. All portable fire extinguishers shall be in clear view and
3 immediately available for use.

4 B. The provisions of this section shall cease to have the force
5 and effect of law on November 1, 2025.

6 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
