7 An Act relating to fire suppression; providing for
8 portable fire extinguishers in mobile food
9 establishments; providing for annual inspection;
10 providing termination date; providing for
11 codification; and declaring an emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 325.20 of Title 74, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. In lieu of an automatic fire extinguishing system, portable
17 fire extinguishers shall be installed in mobile food establishments
18 that produce smoke or grease-laden vapors. All fire extinguishers
19 shall be inspected annually by a licensed contractor. A Class K-
20 rated, portable fire extinguisher is required for all cooking
21 equipment involving solid fuels or vegetable or animal oils and
22 fats. All portable fire extinguishers shall be in clear view and
23 immediately available for use.

1 B. The provisions of this section shall cease to have the force
2 and effect of law on November 1, 2025.

3 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
4 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
5 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
6 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
