14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 325.20 of Title 74, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. In lieu of an automatic fire extinguishing system, portable
19	fire extinguishers shall be installed in mobile food establishments
20	that produce smoke or grease-laden vapors. All fire extinguishers
21	shall be inspected annually by a licensed contractor. A Class K-
22	rated, portable fire extinguisher is required for all cooking
23	equipment involving solid fuels or vegetable or animal oils and
24	

1	fats. All portable fire extinguishers shall be in clear view and
2	immediately available for use.
3	B. The provisions of this section shall cease to have the force
4	and effect of law on November 1, 2025.
5	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
7	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
