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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 5, Chapter 231, O.S.L.
14	2022 (74 O.S. Supp. 2023, Section 12005), is amended to read as
15	follows:
16	Section 12005. A. As used in this section only of the Energy
17	Discrimination Elimination Act of 2022, "governmental entity" means
18	a state agency <del>or political subdivision</del> , board, commission, or
19	department of this state.
20	B. 1. Except for paragraph 4 of this subsection, this section
21	applies only to a contract that:
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24	ten or more full-time employees, and

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- b. will pay a company One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) or more over the term of the contract that is to be paid wholly or partly from public funds of the governmental entity; provided, however, the provisions of this paragraph shall apply separately to all companies in a multiple party contract.
- 2. Except as provided by paragraph 4 of this subsection, a governmental entity shall not enter into a contract with a company for goods or services unless the contract contains a written verification from the company that it:
  - a. does not boycott energy companies, and
  - b. will not boycott energy companies during the term of the contract.
- 3. Except as provided by paragraph 4 of this subsection, a governmental entity shall not enter into a contract for goods or services with a listed financial company under Section  $\frac{3}{2003}$  of this  $\frac{3}{2003}$  this  $\frac{3}{200$ 
  - 4. Paragraphs 2 and 3 of this subsection shall not apply to:
    - a. a governmental entity that determines the requirements of paragraphs paragraph 2 or 3 of this subsection are inconsistent with the governmental entity's constitutional or statutory duties related to the issuance, incurrence, or management of debt

2	borrowing, or investment of funds, and
3	b. a contract for which a governmental body determines
4	the supplies or services to be provided are not
5	otherwise reasonably available from a company that is
6	not a listed financial company under Section $\frac{3}{2}$

8	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
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
