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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 62 O.S. 2011, Section 34.6, as
16	last amended by Section 1, Chapter 342, O.S.L. 2013 (62 O.S. Supp.
17	2019, Section 34.6), is amended to read as follows:
18	Section 34.6 A. The Director of the Office of Management and
19	Enterprise Services shall have the power and duty under the
20	direction of the Governor to:
21	1. Prepare the budget document and assist in the drafting of
22	legislation to make it effective;
23	2. Make field surveys and studies of governmental agencies,

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looking toward economy and greater efficiency;

3. Make allotments to control expenditures;

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- 4. Authorize transfers of appropriation appropriations authorized by law;
- 5. Study accounting and other reports rendered by the Central Accounting and Reporting Division;
- 6. Enter into agreements with the United States Secretary of the Treasury for the purpose of implementing federal law;
- 7. Aid the Governor in the economical management of state affairs; and
- 8. Adopt such rules and regulations concerning the exercise of powers and duties as the Director shall deem appropriate, in accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act.
- B. In addition to other duties, the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall, upon request, advise and consult with members of the Legislature and legislative committees concerning revenue and expenditures of state agencies.
- C. Not later than December 31, 2013, the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall provide the Legislature with a proposal to consolidate, streamline, and reduce the size of the administrative code of the agencies consolidated pursuant to House Bill No. 2140 of the 1st Session of the 53rd Oklahoma Legislature. The recommendation shall contain the Director's advice on the possibility of consolidating the affected code into a single title.

1	D. In addition to the powers and duties prescribed by
2	subsection A of this section, the Director shall ensure state
3	agencies are charged no more than the actual cost of the services
4	provided by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services. Such
5	charges shall not include costs related to administration, overhead,
6	insurance or any other additional costs indirectly related to the
7	services provided.
8	E. The State Auditor and Inspector shall settle any dispute if
9	a state agency disagrees with the charges of the services provided
10	by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

F. For purposes of this section, "state agency" includes any office, officer, bureau, board, council, court, commission, institution, unit, division, body or house of the legislative, executive or judicial branches of the state government, whether elected or appointed, excluding only political subdivisions of the state.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
