3 C. The State Department of Education shall publish a list of 4 approved hardwired and mobile panic alert systems. At a minimum, an 5 approved school security alert and response system shall:

Automatically alert designated school personnel when an
 emergency response is initiated on-site by smartphone application,
 phone call, text message, or other technology;

9 2. Provide emergency responders with floor plans, caller 10 location, and other information to assist emergency responders 11 during a 9-1-1 call; and

Integrate designated school personnel with emergency
 responders to provide real-time situational updates during an
 emergency.

D. It is the intent of the Legislature that the State Board of
Education shall use funds appropriated for the support of public
school activities to implement the provisions of this section.
SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
