10 An Act relating to wildlife; authorizing the  
11 Department of Wildlife Conservation to produce  
12 certain study; requiring distribution of report to  
13 the Legislature and Governor; specifying geographic  
14 location for study; allowing the Department to use  
15 certain sources for data; permitting Department to  
16 enter into certain agreements to assist in data  
17 collection; allowing for Department to make  
18 recommendations; providing for codification; and  
19 providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-316 of Title 29, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Department of Wildlife Conservation shall produce an elk  
population study to be presented electronically to the Legislature  
and the Governor within one (1) year of the effective date of this  
act.

1 B. The study shall be used to determine Oklahoma's elk  
2 population in southeastern Oklahoma. The study may incorporate  
3 information available in other sources, such as studies produced by  
4 collegiate or federal resources, into an analysis of Oklahoma's elk  
5 population. The Department may also enter into agreements with  
6 other agencies, organizations operating in this state, or tribal  
7 governments to assist with the production of this study.

8 C. The study may include recommendations by the Department for  
9 the conservation of Oklahoma elk populations.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
