HOUSE BILL 4135

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to infertility insurance coverage; creating the Promoting Pregnancy Act; requiring insurance coverage for certain infertility care for state employees; specifying terms of coverage; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1307.4 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Promoting Pregnancy Act".

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1307.5 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Any insurance plan provided by the Employees Group Insurance Division of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services, that is offered, issued, or renewed in this state on or after the

1 effective date of this act, which provides medical and surgical  
2 benefits, shall provide coverage for infertility care, including but  
3 not limited to:

- 4 1. An anti-Mullerian Hormone test at the age of twenty-eight;
- 5 2. Transvaginal ultrasound; and
- 6 3. Blood tests for the following:
  - 7 a. ABO Group and Rh type and ABORh interpretation,
  - 8 b. comprehensive metabolic panel,
  - 9 c. complete blood count with automated differential,
  - 10 d. E2-estradiol,
  - 11 e. FSH-follicle stimulating hormone,
  - 12 f. LH-luteinizing hormone,
  - 13 g. progesterone level,
  - 14 h. thyroid analyzer, and
  - 15 i. GFR calculation.

16 B. Coverage under this section shall not be subject to any  
17 annual deductible, copayments, or coinsurance limits as established  
18 for all covered benefits under the health benefit plans.

19 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.

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
