12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-115.13 of Title 26, unless
15	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a person who is
17	convicted of a crime shall retain the right to vote by absentee
18	ballot in a primary or general election at the person's last
19	voluntary residence during the term of the person's commitment under
20	a sentence of confinement provided the person otherwise fulfills all
21	voting requirements.

1	B. No person sentenced to the custody of the Department of
2	Corrections shall use the place of involuntary confinement as the
3	person's place of residence for the purpose of qualifying to vote.
4	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
