fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of
monies received by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education
from state appropriations for the purpose of this fund. All monies
accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may
be budgeted and expended by the State Regents for the purpose of
operating the Needed Oklahoma Workers Fund.

SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3235.3 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Universities within The Oklahoma State System of Higher

Education shall receive one-third (1/3) of the monies within the

Needed Oklahoma Workers Fund for nursing students. The money shall
be divided amongst the universities on a per enrolled nursing

student basis.

SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3235.4 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Universities within The Oklahoma State System of Higher

Education shall receive one-third (1/3) of the monies within the

Needed Oklahoma Workers Fund for engineering students. The money

shall be divided amongst the universities on a per enrolled

engineering student basis.
