- A Concurrent Resolution proclaiming February 8 to February 14 as Oklahoma Homeschool Week; recognizing the 30th Anniversary of the Oklahoma Home Educators' Capitol Day event; and directing distribution.

1 WHEREAS, few events have defined the identity of home education 2 in the State of Oklahoma as distinctly or as powerfully as the 3 Oklahoma Home Educators' Capitol Day event; and WHEREAS, Tuesday, February 10, 2015, will be the 30th Oklahoma 4 5 Home Educators' Capitol Day event; and 6 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Home Educators' Capitol Day event has 7 transformed the understanding of the home educator of civic responsibility, educational equality and the importance of building 8 9 relationships with our elected officials; and 10 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Home Educators' Capitol Day event has 11 raised awareness of alternate and viable forms of education and 12 demonstrated that families who choose this form of education are 13 serious about their freedom; and 14 WHEREAS, after thirty years, home educators can still celebrate 15 this freedom and renew their commitment to continue the homeschool 16 legacy for future generations; and 17 WHEREAS, through the lens of history the progress of the past 18 thirty years may seem insignificant; however, home educators can 19 remember their triumphs of defeating unnecessary or burdensome 20 legislation and remember the true victories which are the 21 relationships that have been forged between legislators and 22 homeschool constituents; and 23 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Home Educators' Capitol Day event provides 24 a backdrop for remembering those pioneers who forged the way when
