9	A Concurrent Resolution mourning the loss of Oklahomans due to COVID-19; expressing condolences to
10	those who have lost friends and family and asking for
11	prayers on behalf of all Oklahomans impacted by the pandemic.

14	WHEREAS, Oklahoma's first major public health challenge occurred
15	just 11 years after statehood, in 1918, with the outbreak of the
16	state's first cases of what was commonly called the Spanish
17	influenza, a pandemic that had already been rampant in Europe; and
18	WHEREAS, between October 1, 1918, and April 1, 1919, a reported
19	7,350 Oklahomans died of Spanish influenza and related secondary
20	infections; and
21	WHEREAS, just over 100 years later on March 6, 2020, Oklahoma
22	once again was impacted by a global pandemic, with the state's first
23	case of COVID-19 announced by Governor Kevin Stitt, the Oklahoma
24	State Department of Health and the Tulsa Health Department; and

WHEREAS, the state's first COVID-19 death occurred on March 18,
 2020; and

3 WHEREAS, nearly three years later, the death toll has approached 4 nearly 18,000 Oklahoma parents, grandparents, children, friends and 5 co-workers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
OF THE 1st SESSION OF THE 59th OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE
CONCURRING THEREIN;

9 THAT the Oklahoma Legislature joins the citizens of this state10 in mourning those lives lost.

11 THAT the Oklahoma Legislature expresses its deepest condolences 12 to all who have lost friends and loved ones.

13 THAT the Oklahoma Legislature asks for continuing prayers for 14 all who have been impacted by the pandemic.
