12	WHEREAS, June 15, 2015, will mark the 800th anniversary of the
13	signing of Magna Carta in Runnymede Meadow near Windsor, England;
14	and
15	WHEREAS, in 1215, Magna Carta merely gave expression to a
16	political settlement between rebellious English barons and a
17	recalcitrant king; however, in succeeding centuries this great
18	document came to be considered a "talisman of liberty", giving
19	impetus to the rule of law and constitutional government; and
20	WHEREAS, by means of a minor wording change in the final version
21	of the document, the substitution of the term "any freeman" for "any
22	baron", Magna Carta became the basis for the idea of natural and
23	inalienable rights for all citizens; and

1 WHEREAS, Magna Carta was one of the earliest written expressions 2 of natural and inalienable rights, laying some of the theoretical groundwork for the English Bill of Rights of 1689, the American 3 4 Declaration of Independence, the United States Constitution and Bill 5 of Rights, and the Oklahoma Constitution; and 6 WHEREAS, Magna Carta embodied the concept of right to due 7 process of law, now considered to be a basic tenet of freedom, and 8 contained the first written definition of habeas corpus; and 9 WHEREAS, Magna Carta contained the idea of consent of the 10 governed, leading eventually to representative government in the 11 form of the British Parliament, the American colonial assemblies, 12 the Continental Congress, the United States Congress, and the state 13 and territorial legislatures; and 14 WHEREAS, more importantly, Magna Carta aided in the 15 establishment of the notion that all persons, whether king, 16 president or magistrate, are subject to the rule of law, 17 acknowledging the sovereignty of the people and securing individual 18 liberty against the arbitrary whims of a tyrant; and 19 WHEREAS, our Founding Fathers, well aware of the history and 20 tradition of Magna Carta, relied heavily on this document in the 21 formation of America's great expressions of freedom - the

Declaration of Independence and the United States Constitution.
