9 AS INTRODUCED

10 A Resolution celebrating the thirty-fifth anniversary
11 of the Sister-State relationship between the State of
12 Oklahoma and Taiwan; expressing support for Taiwan's
13 growing role in the international community;
14 recognizing the May 2014 mutual agreement on the
15 Reciprocal Issuance of Driver Licenses; commending
16 Taiwan for its East China Sea Peace Initiative; and
17 directing distribution.

18 WHEREAS, the expansion of Taiwan's role in the international
19 community will enhance the important relationship between Taiwan and
20 the United States, which is supported by the common values of
21 freedom, limited government, the rule of law, and a commitment to a
22 free market economy; and

23 WHEREAS, a Bilateral Investment Agreement (BIA) and a Free Trade
24 Agreement (FTA) between Taiwan and the United States, and Taiwan's
inclusion in the Trans-Pacific Partnership (TPP), as well as
Taiwan's meaningful participation as an observer in the

1 International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO), will contribute to
2 its prosperity, and to the synergies created by the close and
3 dynamic partnership between Taiwan and the United States; and

4 WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma and Taiwan initiated a Sister-
5 State Agreement on July 25, 1980, have enjoyed the benefits of the
6 bonds of friendship and goodwill since that time, and now prepare to
7 celebrate their thirty-fifth anniversary in 2015; and

8 WHEREAS, the United States ranks as Taiwan's second largest
9 trading partner and Taiwan is the tenth largest trading partner of
10 the United States. Bilateral trade in goods and services between
11 the United States and Taiwan reached \$67.4 billion in 2014.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
13 OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 55TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE
14 CONCURRING THEREIN:

15 THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature hereby celebrates the
16 thirty-fifth anniversary of the Sister-State relationship between
17 the State of Oklahoma and Taiwan and expresses its steadfast support
18 for Taiwan's growing role in the international community.

19 THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature hereby recognizes the mutual
20 benefit to business and travel created by the May 2014 mutual
21 agreement between the Oklahoma Department of Public Safety and the
22 Republic of China (Taiwan) through the Ministry of Transportation
23 and Communications on the Reciprocal Issuance of Driver Licenses.

1 THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature hereby commends Taiwan,
2 under the leadership of President Ma Ying-jeou, for its East China
3 Sea Peace Initiative, which promotes peace and stability by
4 providing political and economic cooperation and common ground for
5 all parties and brings economic vitality to a troubled zone.

6 THAT an official copy of this resolution be distributed to the
7 Honorable Louis Min-Jing Huang, Director General of the Taipei
8 Economic and Cultural Office in Houston, as an expression of the
9 sentiment of the Oklahoma State Legislature.
