1	overreach by federal agencies and excessive and burdensome
2	imposition by the federal government upon the states.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE

CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Legislature of the State of Oklahoma hereby recommends to the Congress of the United States that an amendment to the United States Constitution be adopted that is substantially similar to the following:

"Section 1. The seventeenth article of amendment to the Constitution of the United States is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Senators shall be elected exclusively by the State Legislature, upon a majority of legislators present and voting in a joint session. If a vacancy shall exist for more than one hundred eighty (180) days, then the Governor shall appoint the Senator to serve the remainder of the vacant term. This procedure may not be modified by state initiative or referendum.

Section 3. State Legislatures may issue instructions to, or recall, their Senators at any time.

Section 4. Any Senators serving at the time this amendment becomes a valid part of the Constitution shall complete their current terms of office."
