10	for the 59th Oklahoma Legislature; amending certain deadlines.
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13	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
14	OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE
15	CONCURRING THEREIN:
16	SECTION 1. Pursuant to the provisions of subsection (c) of
17	Joint Rule 7 of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, as set forth in
18	Enrolled Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 5 of the 1st Session of
19	the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the legislative procedural schedule
20	is amended to read as follows:
21	RULE SEVEN
22	LEGISLATIVE SCHEDULE
23	(a) The First Regular Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature
24	shall adhere to the following procedure schedule:

January 19, 2023, no later than 4:00 p.m., shall be the
 deadline for introduction of bills and joint resolutions in the
 Senate and House of Representatives for consideration on the floor
 of the House of Representatives or Senate during the First Regular
 Session.

March 23, 2023, shall be the final legislative day for Third
Reading and Final Passage of a bill or joint resolution in the
chamber of origin.

9 3. April 27, 2023, shall be the final legislative day for Third
 10 Reading and Final Passage of a bill or joint resolution in the
 11 chamber opposite the chamber of origin.

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 4. The First Regular Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature
 13 shall adjourn sine die not later than 5:00 p.m. on May 26, 2023.

<sup>14</sup> 5. Upon a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the membership of both <sup>15</sup> chambers, a bill or joint resolution may be exempted from all <sup>16</sup> deadline dates in both chambers; provided, each chamber may adopt <sup>17</sup> rules which supersede the provisions of this Rule.

18 (b) The Second Regular Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature 19 shall adhere to the following procedure schedule:

20 1. December 8, 2023, shall be the final date for requesting the 21 drafting of bills and joint resolutions in the House of 22 Representatives and Senate for introduction for consideration during 23 the Second Regular Session.

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January 18, 2024, no later than 4:00 p.m., shall be the
 deadline for introduction of bills and joint resolutions in the
 Senate and House of Representatives for consideration on the floor
 of the House of Representatives or Senate during the Second Regular
 Session.

3. The Second Regular Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature
7 shall convene at twelve noon on February 5, 2024.

8 4. March 21, 2024 March 14, 2024, shall be the final
 9 legislative day for Third Reading and Final Passage of a bill or
 10 joint resolution in the chamber of origin.

5. April 25, 2024, shall be the final legislative day for Third Reading and Final Passage of a bill or joint resolution in the chamber opposite the chamber of origin.

14 6. The Second Regular Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature 15 shall adjourn sine die not later than 5:00 p.m. on May 31, 2024.

<sup>16</sup> 7. Upon a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the membership of both <sup>17</sup> chambers, a bill or joint resolution can be exempted from all <sup>18</sup> deadline dates in both chambers; provided, each chamber may adopt <sup>19</sup> rules which supersede the provisions of this Rule.

(c) This schedule may be amended or modified by the adoption of a concurrent resolution by a majority vote of the membership of each chamber.

(d) This schedule shall be inapplicable to any joint resolution introduced for the purpose of disapproving or approving agency rules 1 pursuant to the provisions of the Administrative Procedures Act, or 2 for the purpose of disapproving or approving standards adopted by 3 the State Board of Education as set forth in Section 11-103.6a-1 of 4 Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

5 This schedule shall be inapplicable to any bills introduced (e) 6 for the purposes of incorporating and merging different versions of a statute amended in more than one measure at the same or different sessions of the Legislature as set forth in Section 23.1 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

10 This schedule shall be inapplicable to any bill or joint (f) 11 resolution introduced for the purpose of approving, disapproving, 12 repealing or modifying rules of the Ethics Commission pursuant to 13 the provisions of Section 3 of Article XXIX of the Oklahoma 14 Constitution.

15 This schedule shall be inapplicable to any bill or joint (a) 16 resolution which proposes a special or local law and for which 17 notice of intended introduction is published in a newspaper for four 18 consecutive weeks pursuant to the provisions of Section 32 of 19 Article V of the Oklahoma Constitution.

20 (h) The dates specified in this Rule for introduction of bills 21 or joint resolutions shall be inapplicable to any bill or joint 22 resolution which contains an "RB" number pursuant to the provisions 23 of the Oklahoma Pension Legislation Actuarial Analysis Act. Such 24 measures shall be submitted to the legislative actuary not later \_ \_

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<sup>1</sup> than such dates, and may be introduced not later than the first <sup>2</sup> Monday in February following such submission.

(i) This schedule shall be inapplicable to any bill or joint resolution authored by the chairs and vice-chairs of the Senate Appropriations Committee and the House Appropriations and Budget Committee which affects the receipt, expenditure or budgeting of state funds or funds under the control of an entity created by state law.

9 (j) This schedule shall be inapplicable to any bill or joint
 10 resolution authored by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and
 11 the Speaker of the House of Representatives which is deemed by them
 12 to be necessary for the preservation of public peace, health or
 13 safety.

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
