1 the emoluments of which shall have been increased, during his or her term of office, nor shall any member receive any appointment from 2 the Governor, the Governor and Senate, or from the Legislature, 3 during the term for which he or she shall have been elected, nor 5 shall any member, during the term for which he or she shall have been elected, or within two years thereafter, be interested, 6 7 directly or indirectly, in any contract with the State, or any county or other subdivision thereof, authorized by law passed during 8 the term for which he or she shall have been elected. 10 B. A member of the Legislature may, immediately following the 11 term for which he or she was elected be employed with a public 12 school district in this state to serve as district superintendent, 13 principal, supervisor, a counselor, librarian, school nurse or 14 classroom teacher or in any other instructional, supervisory or 15 administrative capacity. This subsection shall only apply to a 16 person that holds a valid certificate issued by and in accordance 17 with the rules of the State Board of Education or the rules of the 18 State Board of Career and Technology Education to perform the 19 particular services for which the person is employed. 20 SECTION 2.
