Federal Election Commission, No. 22 08-205, 558 U.S. 310 (2010) and hereby applies to the Congress, 23 under the provisions of Article V of the United States Constitution,

for the calling of a Convention of the States limited to proposing

an amendment to the United States Constitution to address issues arising under the First Amendment.

THAT this application is to be considered as covering the same subject matter as the presently outstanding applications from other states and shall be aggregated with the presently outstanding applications of other states for the purpose of attaining the two-thirds (2/3) of states necessary to require the calling of an Article V Convention for proposing a change in the First Amendment, but shall not be aggregated with any applications on any other subject.

THAT if the Convention called by the Congress is not limited to considering changes in the First Amendment, then any delegates, representatives, or participants from the State of Oklahoma asked to participate in the Convention are authorized to debate and vote only on a proposed amendment or amendments to the United States

Constitution related to changes in the First Amendment.

THAT no delegate from this state to a Convention shall have the authority to vote to allow consideration of or vote to approve an unauthorized amendment. Any delegate casting a vote to allow consideration or approval of an unauthorized amendment shall be immediately recalled by the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate and replaced by an alternate.

THAT a delegate or alternate from this state to the Convention shall be required to take the following oath:

"I do solemnly swear or affirm that to the best of my abilities,
I will, as a delegate or alternate to an Article V Convention,
uphold the Constitution and laws of the United States of America and
the State of Oklahoma. I will not vote to allow consideration of or
to approve any unauthorized amendment proposed for ratification to
the United States of America Constitution."

THAT any delegate who violates the oath contained in this resolution, upon conviction, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

THAT this application constitutes a continuing application in accordance with Article V of the United States Constitution until the Legislatures of at least two-thirds (2/3) of the several states have made applications on the same subject or the Congress has proposed an amendment to the United States Constitution equivalent to the amendment proposed in this resolution. This application supersedes any previous application by the Legislature of the State of Oklahoma on the same subject.

THAT copies of this resolution shall be dispatched by the Oklahoma Secretary of State to the President Pro Tempore and Secretary of the United States Senate, to the Speaker and Clerk of the United States House of Representatives, to the Oklahoma Congressional Delegation, and to the presiding officers of each of
