10	A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State to refer to the people for their approval or
11	rejection a proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma by adding a new Section 38 to
12	Article II; guaranteeing the right to engage in certain farming and ranching practices; prohibiting
13	Legislature from passing certain laws; providing for interpretation; providing ballot title; and directing
14	filing.

17	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
18	1ST SESSION OF THE 55TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
19	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
20	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
21	the following proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of
22	Oklahoma by adding a new Section 38 to Article II thereof, to read
23	as follows:
24	

1 Section 38. To protect agriculture as a vital sector of 2 Oklahoma's economy, which provides food, energy, health benefits, 3 and security and is the foundation and stabilizing force of Oklahoma's economy, the rights of citizens and lawful residents of 4 5 Oklahoma to engage in farming and ranching practices shall be forever guaranteed in this state. The Legislature shall pass no law 6 7 which abridges the right of citizens and lawful residents of Oklahoma to employ agricultural technology and livestock production 8 9 and ranching practices without a compelling state interest. 10 Nothing in this section shall be construed to modify any provision of common law or statutes relating to trespass, eminent 11 12 domain, dominance of mineral interests, easements, rights of way or any other property rights. 13 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional 14 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in 15 the following form: 16 BALLOT TITLE 17 Legislative Referendum No. 18 State Question No. THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS: 19 This measure adds a new section of law to the State 20 Constitution. It adds Section 38 to Article 2. It protects the 21 rights of citizens and lawful residents of Oklahoma to engage in 22 farming and ranching practices. It prohibits the Legislature 23 from passing laws that would take away the right to employ 24
