## $\underline{\text { AS INTRODUCED }}$

A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of state to refer to the people for their approval or rejection the repeal of Section 59 of Article $V$ of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma, which relates to special laws; providing ballot title; and directing filing.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, the repeal of Section 59 of Article $V$ of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma which relates to special laws.

SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in the following form:

Legislative Referendum No. $\qquad$ State Question No. $\qquad$ THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

This measure would repeal Section 59 of Article 5 of the Oklahoma Constitution which provides that laws of a general nature be given uniform operation and that if a general law can be made to apply, a special law shall not be enacted. SHALL THE PROPOSAL BE APPROVED?

SECTION 3. The Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives, immediately after the passage of this resolution, shall prepare and file one copy thereof, including the Ballot Title set forth in SECTION 2 hereof, with the Secretary of State and one copy with the Attorney General.
