8	A Joint Resolution calling for a convention to propose a balanced budget amendment pursuant to the provisions of Article V of the United States

13	WHEREAS, the citizens of the State of Oklahoma believe that it
14	is in the best interest of the people of the United States to amend
15	the United States Constitution in order to adopt a balanced budget
16	amendment; and
17	WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Article V of the
18	Constitution of the United States, each state may request Congress
19	to provide for a convention to propose amendments.
20	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
21	AND THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 55TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
22	SECTION 1. The Oklahoma Legislature hereby applies to Congress,
23	under the provisions of Article V of the Constitution of the United
24	States, for the calling of a convention of the states limited to

proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States requiring that in the absence of a national emergency the total of all federal appropriations made by the Congress for any fiscal year may not exceed the total of all estimated federal revenues for that fiscal year, together with any related and appropriate fiscal restraints.

SECTION 2. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to transmit copies of this application to the President and Secretary of the United States Senate, the Speaker and Clerk of the United States House of Representatives and members of the United States Senate and House of Representatives from this state; also to transmit copies hereof to the presiding officers of the legislative houses in several states, requesting their cooperation.

SECTION 3. This application is to be considered as covering the same subject matter as the presently outstanding balanced budget applications from other states, including, but not limited to, previously adopted applications from Alabama, Alaska, Arkansas, Colorado, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Louisiana, Maryland, Michigan, Mississippi, Missouri, Nebraska, Nevada, New Hampshire, New Mexico, North Carolina, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Tennessee and Texas; and this application shall be aggregated with same for the purpose of attaining the two-thirds (2/3) of states necessary to require the calling of a convention,
