7 AS INTRODUCED

8 A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State  
9 to refer to the people for their approval or  
10 rejection a proposed amendment to Section 14 of  
11 Article VI of the Constitution of the State of  
12 Oklahoma; modifying reference; providing ballot  
13 title; and directing filing.

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE  
15 1ST SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

16 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for  
17 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,  
18 the following proposed amendment to Section 14 of Article VI of the  
19 Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:

20 Section 14. In case of a disagreement between the two ~~houses~~  
21 chambers of the Legislature, at a regular or special session, with  
22 respect to the time of adjournment, the Governor may, if the facts  
23 be certified to him, by the presiding officer of the house first  
24 moving the adjournment, adjourn them to such time as he shall deem

1 proper, not beyond the day of the next stated meeting of the  
2 Legislature. He may convoke the Legislature at or adjourn it to  
3 another place, when, in his opinion, the public safety or welfare,  
4 or the safety or health of the members require it: Provided,  
5 however, That such change or adjournment shall be concurred in by a  
6 two-thirds vote of all the members elected to each branch of the  
7 Legislature.

8 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional  
9 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in  
10 the following form:

13 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

14 This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It amends  
15 Section 14 of Article 6. This section has provisions related to  
16 adjournment of legislative sessions and the location of the  
17 Legislature. It changes a reference.

18 SHALL THE PROPOSAL BE APPROVED?
